House Committee on Financial Services

Congressman Cazayoux has been named to the House Committee on Financial Services. He serves on the Capital Markets, Insurance, and Government Sponsored Enterprises subcommittee and the Housing and Community Opportunity subcommittee. From his position on these subcommittees, Congressman Cazayoux is able to work on two very important issues for Louisiana: lowering the cost of homeowners' insurance and increasing access to affordable and quality housing.

House Committee on Veterans' Affairs

His second committee assignment is the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs. Within the committee, Congressman Cazayoux serves on the subcommittee on Health. With nearly 50,000 veterans living in the 6th District and the number of veterans increasing in America, it is incredibly important to honor our veterans. Veterans' health is an incredibly important issue, even more so after the revelations about the substandard conditions at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. The Department of Veterans Affairs spends over \$45 million on veterans' health care in the 6th District alone, making it a very important issue for our district. Congressman Cazayoux has assembled a Veterans' Advisory Council made up of 6th District veterans to advise him on policy relating to veterans.
