Congressman Cazayoux to Serve on the Financial Services Committee

WASHINGTON, DC- The House Democratic Steering and Policy Committee voted today to recommend that Congressman Don Cazayoux (LA-06) serve on the Financial Services Committee.

"I am honored to have the opportunity to serve on the Financial Services Committee and be able to take the lead on issues important to the middle-class families of Louisiana's 6th District," said Congressman Cazayoux.
