Congressman Cazayoux's Statement on Thursday's Supreme Court decision overturning Washington, D.C.'s gun ban:

"As an avid sportsman and gun owner, I am very pleased that the Supreme Court has reaffirmed Americans' right to bear arms. I agree with the court that the 2nd Amendment guarantees an individual's right to bear arms and the ban on handguns in the District of the Columbia violated that principle. In fact, one of the first pieces of legislation I co-sponsored was the District of Columbia Personal Protection Act, which sought to overturn the gun ban. I will always stand with lawful gun owners who are exercising their Constitutional rights and I am glad the Supreme Court agrees."
